



Rule Book

The LASN Golf tour is a social golf tour designed to have fun playing golf while making new friends in a competitive yet fun golf atmosphere. Each season consists of a year of monthly tournaments where you will earn LASN Cup points towards the end of season Championship in Las Vegas. Each tournament you also have the opportunity to play for prizes and win prizes as that months tournament champion.

For each tournament the registration fee will include your green fees, golf cart and entry into the longest drive and closest to pin competitions. You also can pay \$10 to join the opt in hole challenge with a chance to win prizes and a larger prize if closest to the pin within 10 feet. Each tournament also offers a 50/50 raffle with the chance to win money and the remaining proceeds go towards prizes for the next tournament. \$5 from every registration also goes towards the LASN Cup Championship Pool at the end of the season which is split between the 4 winning players (Gross & Net).

While it is encouraged for each player to play with the same teammate throughout the season, people can find new teammates for each tournament. Points will be earned as a team but half will be awarded individually. The LASN Cup Championship will be based on a points total that individuals must meet in order to be eligible to captain a team, commonly known as the "cut".

Seeding for the Championship Tournament will be comprised of the top 12 individual players with each person acting as the "Captain" of each team. Each captain may choose their partner for the championship tournament and can choose any player that

competed during the season as their partner. The caveat is however that if they did not play two times during the season with their partner then they will only be competing for the Gross Championship. Any partners that have competed in 2

or more tournaments during the season will be competing for both Gross and Net. Should two members in the top 12 decide to want to partner, then the individual with the lower seed will forfeit their position and the next in line will move up and in turn, someone sitting in the 13th spot will then move up into the 12th spot and be eligible to "Captain" a team. Winners of any LASN Majors (2 day tournaments) during the season will receive automatic bids to the LASN Cup and must play together in accepting their bid.

Points: The Purse for each tournament will be determined based on the number of teams and there will be a NET (Handicaps) and GROSS (No Handicaps) Standings with teams receiving points based on the average of both standings. The last place receiving 2 points and each team above that receiving an additional 4 points and so forth in each.

Each tournament will declare both a Gross and Net Champion with new partners only competing in Gross for that tournament.

There will be 3 Majors each year (LASN Masters, LASN Open and the LASN Ryder Cup). These will all be 2 day tournaments where LASN Cup Points will be awarded to all of the current tours in your region. For the LASN Masters and LASN Open the winning teams will receive an automatic bid to the LASN Cup Championship.

Each Tournament will use hard copy scorecards that will be the official score while also using 18birdies as the app of choice to track scoring. If a scorecard is handed in incomplete or wrong the team will automatically be disqualified and will receive the lowest amount of LASN Cup points for that tournament. The same will happen for any teams found cheating. Any teams found cheating will not be allowed to return to a LASN Golf Tournament in the future.

Each Tournament will have a purse of LASN Cup Points with 4 points being awarded to the last place team, 8 points to the second to last team and upwards to the winning team so the more teams in the tournament the larger the purse. Teams will split the LASN Cup points with each player taking half for their individual seasonal total.

Any teams that show up late to their tee time will be disqualified and will not be allowed to compete. If a teammate shows up late or no shows a player may be able to begin or play the round by themselves but will only be able to use 1 ball.

During play each player must use 2 tee shots per 9 holes and tee boxes will be determined by the tournament coordinator prior to play. Generally there will be a women's, senior (Over 60) and Men's Tee Box.

Handicap:

New teams will determine their handicaps for their first tournament based on their first 9 holes. After that it is the average score of your last 6 tournaments together.

And finally don't forget to have fun, this is a social golf atmosphere where golfers of all levels are welcome and we are

here to have fun and make friends!
